Dear Parents,

I am excited to inform you children from Year 5 will be going to the **Museum of Power** as part of their Creative curriculum and science unit. Pupils will have the opportunity to deepen their understanding of the importance of the industrial revolution and how forces have an impact on the wider environment. They will be learning skills in a fun and inspiring way.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 27th November 2019**. Pupils will be travelling by coach, leaving school at approximately **8:30am and returning at 4.00pm**. All children will require a packed lunch (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets) and will need to wear school uniform. Please also ensure that your child is wearing comfortable footwear and bring a jacket/coat.

The cost of this trip is £19.00 which must be paid via Parent Pay. We have now moved to cashless payments for school trips. If you have not already done so, **please ensure that you register with Parent Pay with immediate effect**. Please contact the school office who will give you your log in details and assist you if you require any help. PLEASE NOTE – YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GO ON ANY SCHOOL TRIPS IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED ON PARENT PAY.

**Please note that children who are provided with free school meals are exempt from paying but must still give consent on their child's parent pay account.**

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that once the payment has been made it is **non-refundable**.

Children may bring spending money for the onsite shop but this has been set at a maximum of £10. Please ensure that your child has a named purse or envelope to transport their money.

We hope that you will encourage your child to attend this educational visit to support them in their learning.
