Dear Parents/Carers, Please find below the units that your child will be learning this half term.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To follow the classroom and learning environment rules
- To talk about their own feelings, how others are feeling and how their behaviour affects others
- To change and adapt their behaviour to a range of different situations
- To have the confidence to try new activities
- To identify adults who are 'safe adults', which they can speak to.
